Robert Mammano Frezza Memorial Scholarship Fund Announces Doubling of Scholarship Award to Stanford

\$24,000 scholarship to be awarded to graduates of The Lawrenceville School

Lawrenceville, NJ – April 15, 2007 – The Robert Mammano Frezza Memorial Scholarship Fund announced today a doubling of its scholarship grant to \$24,000. Awarded each year to a graduating Lawrenceville School senior planning to attend Stanford University, the Fund has thus far awarded merit scholarships to four outstanding Lawrenceville graduates – Hilary Faust L '03, Elizabeth Riley L '04, Kevin Shan L '05, and Anne Lindseth L '06

The RMF Fund, established in 2003 to honor the memory of Robert M. Frezza (1980-2001), was endowed with contributions from Robert's family, friends, coworkers, and most notably Bob's mentor Max Levchin, founding Chief Technology Officer of PayPal, Inc. Bob was a 1998 graduate of The Lawrenceville School and a senior at Stanford University when he passed away in 2001 shortly before his 22nd birthday.

The scholarship is awarded each year to the Stanford-bound Lawrenceville senior who best exemplifies the values and potential Bob evidenced during his short but dynamic life (see www.bobfrezza.org). Thanks to strong endowment growth, recipients will henceforth receive \$6,000 per year toward tuition for each of their four undergraduate years. Applications are currently being considered from the Class of 2007.

The Robert Mammano Frezza Scholarship Fund is a 501(c)3 charitable trust whose sole purpose is to award scholarships to Stanford University. The Fund's trustees include Regan Kerney from The Lawrenceville School, Professor Dan Boneh from Stanford University, Max Levchin, former CTO of PayPal, Inc., Ken Easwaran (L '98, S '02), and Bob's father William Frezza.
